Quick Dry Rubberized Undercoat is a rapid-drying highly protective automotive coating for autobody interiors, underhood and underbody applications. Resists abrasion and inhibits rust as it seals out dust and moisture. Deadens sound. Excellent adhesion to painted and unpainted surfaces.

Surface Prep & Application

Aerosol: Shake well. Wash and solvent clean surface to remove all rust, dirt and grease using SCAT 6311, Speedi SCAT 6321 or Aqua SCAT 2 1391/1394. Hold can in an upright position and spray 8-10 inches from surface, using steady light strokes. 2 coats (@2.5-3.5 mils per coat) will produce a better finish than one heavy coat. Remove overspray with Acry Solvent 9783/9784.



Quart/Gallon: Stir thoroughly before use. Wash and solvent clean surface to remove all rust, dirt and grease. Apply with a shutz gun, using the gun manufacturer's recommended air pressure. Allow 15 - 20 minutes between coats. Thoroughly clean spray gun with Acry Solvent 9783/9784 immediately after use. Max temperature resistance is 250°F (121°C). NOTE: Topcoating is not recommended. This product contains asphalt which may stain light colored topcoats.
